LLMS Band Philosophy

It is our hope to musically educate our students each day with the long term goal of them becoming successful and independent adults. Our program is designed to take students through the first 3 years of a 7 year process that prepares them to graduate from Willis High School as a 7-year Willis Band member. During this time we train our students in the arts of self-motivation, work ethic, patience, self-determination, team work, individual achievement, responsibility, and leadership using the medium of music.

<u>Charms Office Assistant – REQUIRED FOR ALL STUDENTS</u>

- The password is the student's school ID number. If it does not work, try adding a zero "0" to the beginning.
 - Updated requirements: members logging in for the **first time** will be prompted to create a new password with the following criteria:
 - At least 8 characters.
 - A combination of alpha/numeric characters.
 - One capital letter.

Sectionals - Wind Ensemble & Symphonic Band ONLY!

- Sectionals are counted as a major grade.
- Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Band members will be required to attend weekly sectionals on their assigned day.
 - Please communicate in advance if there are any conflicts.

• Pick-up location is the band hall door in the car-rider line (by flagpole).

Band Handbook

- Detailed information on classroom procedures, after school rehearsals, grading policy, and uniforms are outlined in our handbook.
- Please read through, then complete the handbook acknowledgement form (should be done already!).

After-School Rehearsals

- On the band calendar.
- Rehearsals release at indicated end time, but students still need time to pack up and walk out...please plan accordingly.
- Scheduled ASR's are required to attend and are a major grade.

Practicing

- Practicing outside of the school day is an expectation and requirement for all LLMS Band Members. Practicing, just like exercising, cannot be pushed off to one day a week and still be effective. 30 minutes/day ensures that good habits are being reinforced, students are keeping up with the workload from block scheduling, and pushing themselves on their sectional work.
- Beginner Band members have yellow practice cards and should be currently filling them out. There is a self reflection aspect of this...the goal is to get students to think critically about how they are playing. Every student should be practicing with a metronome!
- Advanced Band members DO NOT have practice cards, HOWEVER they still have playing assignments for homework. They are assigned materials to practice at the end of every class period and/or sectional. See their band binder for more information :-)
